COVID GUIDELINES

Anyone showing symptoms of Covid-19, or who is feeling generally unwell, should not attend services, meetings, or activities.

It is recommended that church buildings and parish halls continue to be as well ventilated as possible.

Social distancing will no longer be required in church buildings and parish halls.

With the continuing rise in infections, we will be taking a cautious approach, and are asking that people continue to sanitise upon entry and exit of the church buildings.

Face coverings will no longer be a requirement in church buildings or parish halls, but those who prefer to continue to use face coverings are clearly free to do so.
